We will implement and maintain procedures to prevent environmental nonconformities and to ensure preparedness and response to potential environmental emergencies, including spills and other unplanned incidents.

We commit to identifying and addressing climate-related risks and opportunities within our management system, aligning with sustainability goals and regulatory requirements to ensure long-term resilience and responsibility
